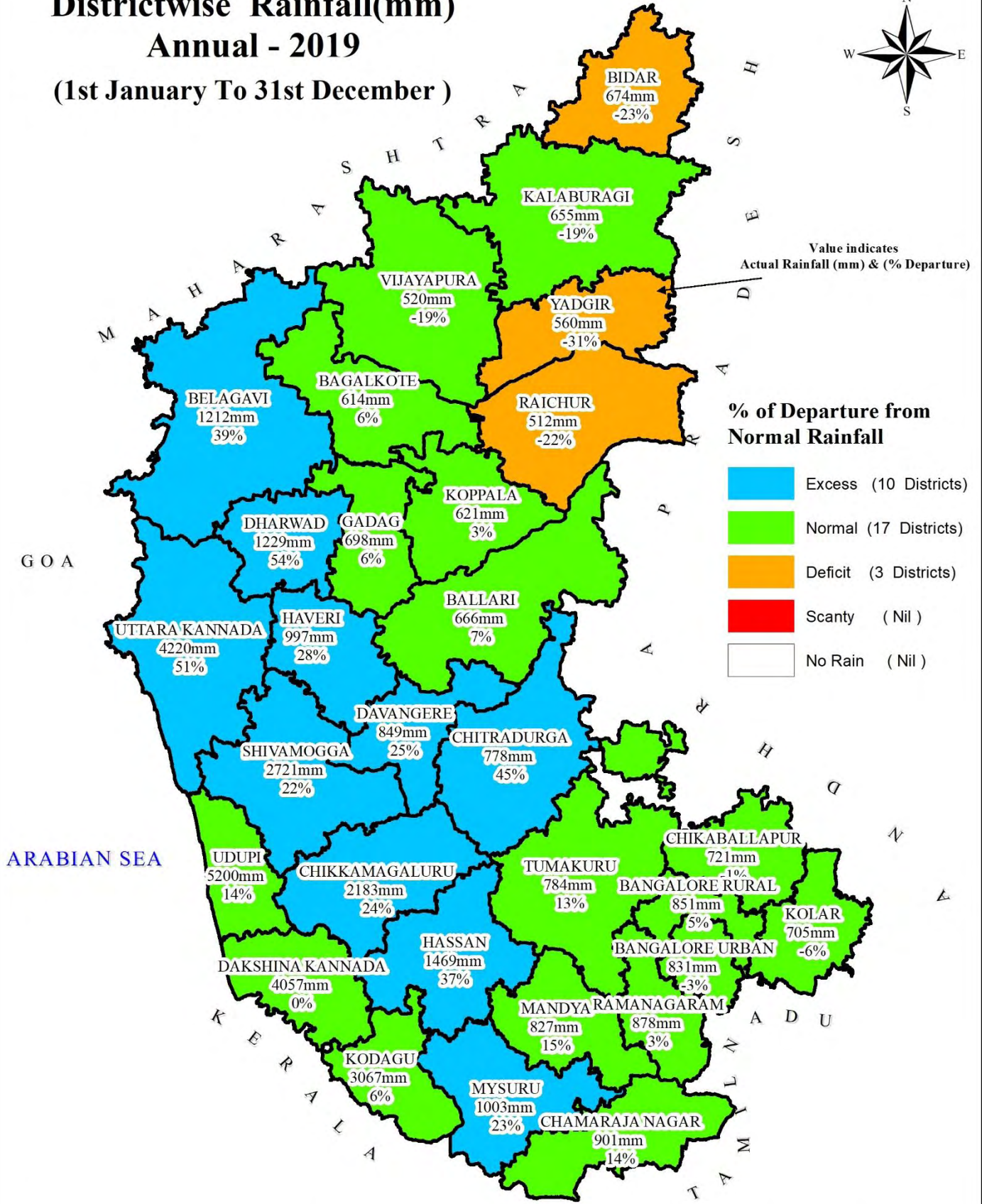
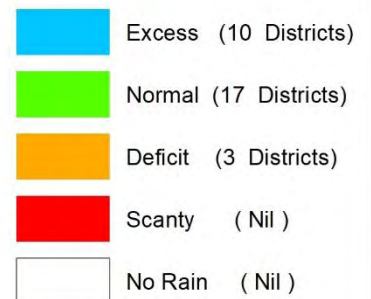

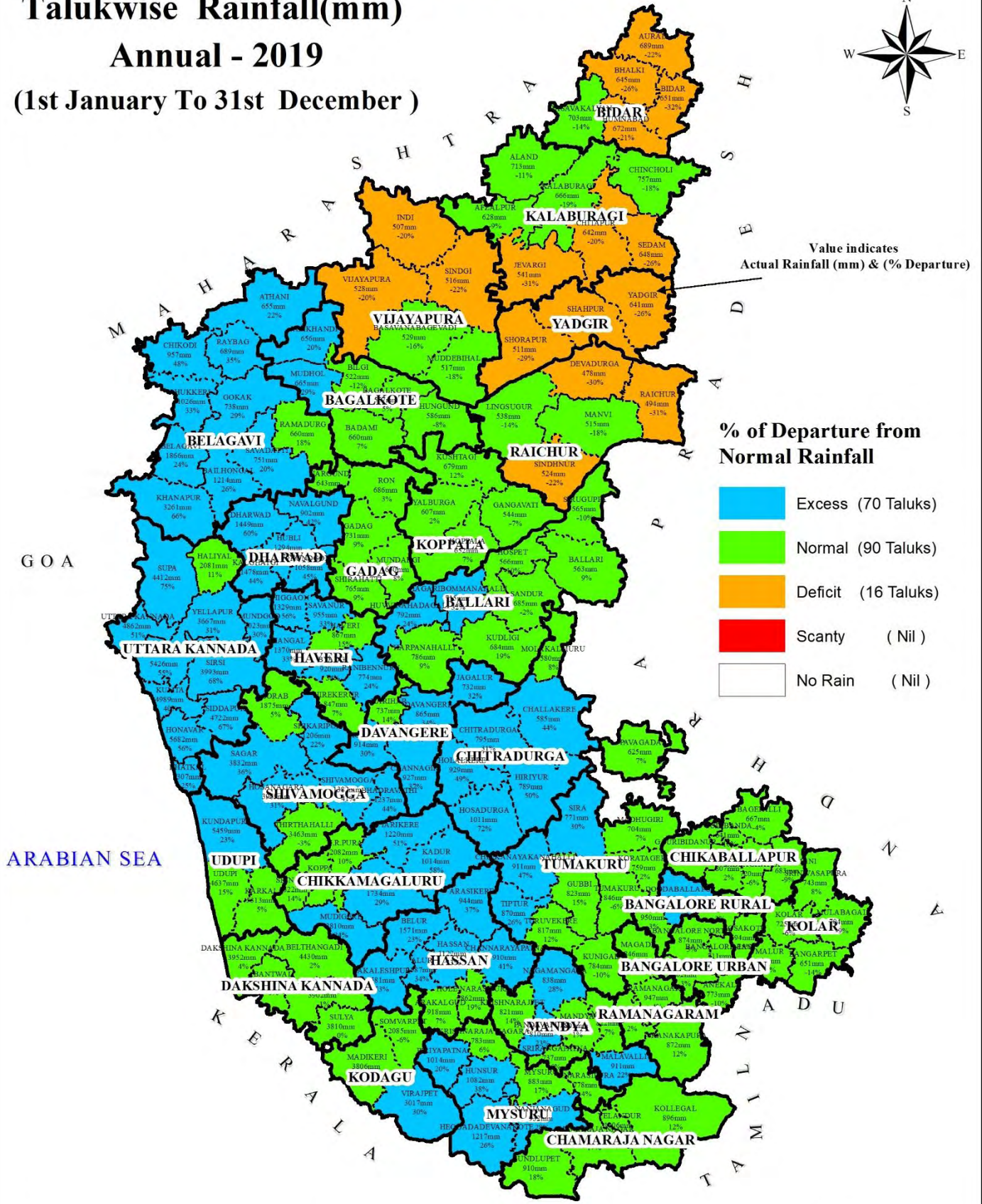
## Talukwise Rainfall(mm) Annual - 2019 (1st January To 31st December)
